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VINEYARD REPORT AUGUST 2026

As expected, the harvest began very early this year, on August 17th in Bully and August 18th in Quincié. This is on par with 2003, an exceptionally early year.

The weather conditions of the past few weeks have further accelerated the process. The grapes have reached excellent and even ripeness, with superb balance (alcohol/acidity/pH), typical of a hot and sunny year.

The vintage is therefore promising in terms of quality but poor in terms of quantity, as previously announced. Hailstorms and drought have significantly reduced the harvest potential; we should expect only half a harvest.

The harvest should last just under a month, in the heat... Get your pruning shears ready!
